



Student Technology Device 2022

At Nagle Catholic College, students supply their own technology device to assist with their learning. The 'Bring Your Own Device' (BYOD) program enables students entering the College in 2022 to choose the device they prefer.

The Leading Lights project, initiated by Catholic Education Western Australia, strongly advocates for schools to embrace Cloud based computing and the integration of Office365 tools.

The information below is intended to assist families in identifying and purchasing suitable devices for their children. Families will need to approach retailers directly or source their requirements from online services.

Regardless of the device chosen, the table below sets out the essential minimum required specifications.

Battery (hours)	8 hours
RAM (gb)	4
Disk (gb)	128 Solid State
Connectivity	Wireless 5ghz

Please note there is no specific device which must be purchased. Rather, families should choose the most appropriate device to suit their situation. To assist with choosing a device, families are encouraged to take this information with them to individual retailers.

Devices not suitable for use:

- Chromebooks
- iPads

Some computers that run Windows will be in 'S Mode' when purchased. This is a special mode that restricts what can be installed on the computer. For students to use the technology effectively, this mode will need to be switched off before attending the college. It prevents printing and other school apps from working. It is important to be aware that any new computer purchased often has an Office Suite on them, this product is usually a trial copy and will expire. As part of every student's enrolment at Nagle, the Office 365 Suite is provided free to all students by the College.
